TRANSPORT ASSISTANCE

The City of Vincent recognises that community funding provides a significant opportunity to work collaboratively with the local groups, organisations and individuals to deliver activities which increase social participation, promote social inclusion and strengthen connections within our community. A variety of funding initiatives are offered each year to meet the diverse range of interests, demands and priorities throughout the Vincent community.

Transport Assistance is provided to eligible residents who have difficulty accessing transport to and from medical appointments. Such assistance is provided through prepaid taxi vouchers.

Vincent provides Transport Assistance up to \$100 for individuals and \$150 for each couple annually.

GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

In order to be eligible for Transport Assistance, you must:

- be the holder of a pension concession card or health care card
- not be accessing transport assistance via a state or federal government aged care package
- not have state funded Taxi User's Subsidy Scheme (TUSS)
- not have a Department of Veteran Affairs (DVA) Health Card
- not have Commonwealth Home Support (CHSP) or Home and Community Care (HACC)
- not have received the maximum amount of Transport Assistance from the City in the current financial year
- not have attended your appointment, as Transport Assistance for past appointments will not be funded

Please provide a copy of your pension concession or health care card.

Applications for Transport Assistance are accepted all year round, however funding is subject to budgetary constraints.
