COMMUNITY FUNDING - ACTIVE TRANSPORT GRANTS - COMMUNITY GROUPS

The City of Vincent recognises that community funding provides a significant opportunity to work collaboratively with the local groups, organisations and individuals to deliver activities which increase social participation, promote social inclusion and strengthen connections within our community. A variety of funding initiatives are offered each year to meet the diverse range of interests, demands and priorities throughout the Vincent community.

Active Transport Community Initiatives Grants provide financial assistance to eligible community groups and not-for-profit organisations to help fund community programs that promote or assists the community to engage in active transport. The grant can be applied to the presentation of a one off event or the development of a program which encourages, supports or celebrates initiatives that promote Vincent residents choosing active transport options.

Grant applications are assessed and approved by Administration based upon funding category guidelines and criteria. An amount up to \$2,500 may be available for each individual program or service through this funding category.

Guidelines and Criteria

Your organisation must

- Your organisation's mission must be aligned with the outcomes of the City of Vincent's Strategic Community Plan 2013 -2017;
- Be a legal entity in Australia with a current ABN;
- Fall in to one or more of the following categories;
 - A Group or community group organisation;
 - A registered charity with the Australian Taxation Office;
 - A deductible gift recipient;
 - A social enterprise;
- Have the ability to demonstrate satisfactory risk management.

What we will fund

The following will be considered for funding:

- Groups in the City of Vincent;
- A collective group of organisations working in partnership to highlight actions related to active transport. Applications need to demonstrate strong elements of collaboration (e.g. partnering with at least one other organisation to create an outcome that neither organisation could achieve on its own);
- Projects that can commence after August of any financial year and be completed by 30 June of the following year;
- Programs that provide education and tools that assist people in taking up active transport;
- Programs that are offered free of charge;
- Programs which have a direct and immediate benefit to City of Vincent residents;
- Applications that demonstrate initiatives, services, projects and resources that contribute to the goal of promoting active transport;
- Only projects with measurable outcomes will be considered. Applications need to outline their
 evaluation strategy and make it clear how outcomes will be measured;
- The City must be satisfied that the applicant organisation has the competency and capacity to implement the project; and
- Evidence that your organisation has successfully completed funded projects before.

Project areas that we cannot fund

The following will *not* be considered for funding:

- Groups and organisations that operate with the aim of making a profit;
- Groups and organisations who have failed to acquit grants awarded to them in any capacity;
- Programs which replicate services already available within the City of Vincent;
- Groups and organisations that have received other significant funding or in kind donation from the City of Vincent;
- Major capital expenditure;
- Debt reduction or operational deficits;
- Operational salaries (however salaries tied to a program or project will be considered);
- Fundraising activities or events;
- Religious organisations where the grant is intended for the principal benefit of the organisation's own members or adherents, or where the grant is intended for inherently religious activities;
- Legal expenses; General construction, capital campaign or renovation unrelated to a specific proposed project or program
- Travel outside Australia;
- Entertainers fees;
- Projects which involve the creation of community art works or gardens; and
- Retrospective funding.

Key dates

Applications for Active Transport Grants can be submitted all year round

Project must commence after August of a financial year and be completed by June 30 of the following year.

Note: Grant funds are to be expended with 3 months of receipt. Financial acquittal and evaluation report will be due within 30 days of project completion.

Please be aware that you will not be eligible for any further funding from the City of Vincent unless an acquittal has been received.
