Function to be performed	A local government may approve of heritage grants as part of the City of Vincent Heritage Assistance Fund.

Delegation	The Chief Executive Officer is delegated the power to approve of heritage grants as part of the City of Vincent Heritage Assistance Fund.

Conditions and Reporting Requirements	<p>Subject to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. adequate funding being available in the City's Heritage Assistance Fund; 2. compliance with the Rules and Requirements for the Heritage Assistance Fund as follows: <p>Eligible Applicants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Property owners whose place is on the City of Vincent's Municipal Heritage Inventory and/or the State Register of Heritage Places; • Community group or non-profit groups who have assumed a long term lease or legal agreement for the maintenance of a building listed on the City's Municipal Heritage Inventory and/or the State Register of Heritage Places; and • Property owners whom have not incurred rates debt with the City of Vincent. <p>Eligible Projects</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conservation/Management Plans; and • Conservation Works. <p>Ineligible Items/Projects</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Operational Costs; • Equipment costs that will be used after the project finishes; • Retrospective funding (i.e. work that has been completed prior to a Heritage Assistance; and • Fund been allocated); and • New additions or extensions. <p>Selection Criteria</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The contribution the proposed work will make to the retention of the heritage listed place; • The degree to which the project is sympathetic to the character and significance of the heritage listed place; • The proposal demonstrates a consistency with the accepted conservation principles outlined in the Burra Charta; • The extent to which the proposal is consistent with the City of Vincent's Residential Design Guidelines and Heritage Management Policies; • The urgency of the conservation work; • Heritage places which have not previously received Heritage Assistance funding; and • Projects, which have a matching or "in-kind" contribution from the landowner. <p>Details of all grants made on behalf of the City are to be recorded in the appropriate file or record.</p>
