###### Comment:

The Consultant provided an overview of the format of the Precinct Parking Management Plans (PPMPs) document, how it was developed (e.g. surveys done), its association with the Draft Review of the Car Parking Strategy and the general issues and recommendations of each PPMP.

The Consultant also outlined that the Precinct Parking Management Plans have been prepared for each of the high activity centres within the Town, comprising Perth, Mount Lawley/Highgate, Mount Hawthorn, North Perth and Leederville. The surveys and analysis undertaken by the Consultants indicated a series of common issues and recommendations to all areas, as well as specific issues and recommendations for each of the five (5) Precincts. The Consultant provided an overview of the list of priorities and methods of implementation to be undertaken in the short, medium and long term, with the intent to improve the Town's approach to parking in line with best practice methodologies.

Key matters of concern that were raised during the Forum included; the Town's approach to cash-in-lieu and how it compares with other Local Government Authorities; and, the need for the Precinct Parking Management Plans to include more detail on appropriate amendments to the parking ratios in the Town's Parking and Access Policy.
