## **Waterwise at Beatty Park**

The Town of Vincent is pleased to announce that Beatty Park Leisure Centre has reduced its water usage by 21% this year. The reduction is also 38% down on the usage recorded two years ago.

"The excellent water savings have largely been made possible by the introduction of pool blankets to cover both indoor and outdoor pools. By recently installing water-saving shower heads we hope to see further reductions in water consumption this year," said Mayor Nick Catania.

"By helping to preserve our precious water resources whilst ensuring that we can all still enjoy our wonderful lifestyle that includes swimming and enjoying water-based activities, Beatty Park is showing its commitment to both the short-term and long-term needs of our community and is constantly searching for ways to conserve water," continued Mayor Catania.

"Another benefit of our reduced water consumption at Beatty Park is financial. The reductions in costs associated with water usage this financial year have helped the economic performance of the Centre. Although the final figures for the year are yet to be determined the results to date are all pointing to an encouraging end to the 2005/06 financial year and a buoyant start to this year," concluded Mayor Catania.
