"I am delighted to announce that a competition is being run to name these two important areas of our Library. This is an opportunity for the young users of these areas to give their sections a name that has some meaning that they can relate to and therefore truly making it an area they can call their own and feel connected to", said Mayor Nick Catania.

The competition is open to all young people in the Vincent community and to local school children.

The winner of the best name for the junior area will receive a backpack filled with goodies and the winner of the best name for the young adult area will take home a 4GB Ipod Nano.

"The Town places a high level of importance on the value of early literacy in the development of the young members of our community, so the junior areas are welcoming, stimulating and easy to use. This area has already proved incredibly popular as juniors are attracted to the bright and welcoming area that is designed not only for learning but for safety," continued Mayor Catania.

"It is equally important for the young adults in our community to have a safe and welcoming place to meet, chill out with a book and study. That's why our young adults' area has a funky coffee-shop feel to it, is more secluded and stocked with items that teens are interested in."
