1. Welcome/Declaration of Opening

3. Confirmation of the Minutes

That the Minutes of the meeting held on 26 February 2025 be received and confirmed as true and correct record.

4. Business

4.1 City of Vincent partnership with SPACED for Know Thy Neighbour #4

- Tom Campbell is the chosen artist for SPACED's Know Thy Neighbour program based in the City of Vincent. TC was drawn to SPACED through their connection and inspiration from the local communities surrounding their residency. Explains their practice as a mixture of movement and texture/objects - currently exploring the tension that is embodied through movement, especially through waacking and street dance battles.
- Advice was sought regarding any connections to individuals, community groups or resources that might benefit their residency.

- A parallel was drawn between SPACED's Know Thy Neighbour program and the 1970s sitcom Love Thy Neighbour which aired in the UK. Love Thy Neighbour was a problematic show with strong racial themes and has become triggering for people of colour from that generation. This information will be passed on to SPACED.

4.2 Artsource Partnership: Halvorsen Hall & Lee Hopps Cottage

- One of the members was involved in a past EOI submission for Halvorsen Hall and would like more information on why it wasn't successful. Admin will pass on to the relevant team to provide more information.
- It was recommended that Artsource be held to strict KPIs to ensure that there are deliverables from the partnership and a shared gameplan for the residencies and artist occupancies. Administration invited AAG members to provide any further comments and suggestions in the coming weeks, but some initial thoughts included workshops, exhibitions and the creation of artworks within a predetermined timeframe.
- It was also proposed that at least one of the occupancies in Artsource's program be filled by a local City of Vincent artist.

4.3 Potential Beatty Park Changeroom Mural Project

- Overview of project and timeline was discussed. Construction will finish in the next 3 months and the mural EOI going out after construction has been completed.
- One member expressed their preference to wrap the entire changeroom in a mural, as just covering one wall would lead to the perception that the project was unfinished. This will depend on budget.
- If a specific wall was to be chosen, it was discussed that the western wall facing the carpark would be the preferred option, as it would provide a pleasant arrival point and would leave the eastern wall to provide a cleaner view from the playing fields to Beatty Park. The northern wall facing the playground could also be a great outcome, to engage children.
- Themes for the mural included considering the site's past, present and future contexts.

The Chairperson closed the meeting at 6:45 pm. The next meeting is scheduled to be held on 03 June 2026.
