I am pleased to present the City's 2019-2020 Annual Report in my first year in the role and I acknowledge the contribution of former CEO Len Kosova in setting us up for future success.

Council adopted a new Strategic Community Plan in October 2019 which established six priorities to guide the City in delivering a range of programs, projects and services.

The organisation has undertaken an extensive corporate planning process to assess its operations and commitments against the new Strategic Community Plan. This is now embedded in a new Corporate Business Plan.

Staff adopted new corporate values of Engaging, Accountable and Making a Difference which guide how we work together to deliver services to our community.
