You can download eBooks and eAudiobooks from the Vincent Library, anytime of the day or night! This service is free with your library card.

Download best-selling novels, well-known classics, kids' books – and much more. Simply browse the collection via our website, check out with your library card, and download to your computer or mobile device. To get started, you just need to install free software.

Titles can be enjoyed immediately or transferred to a variety of devices (like an iPad or eReader) and they will automatically expire at the end of the lending period – no late fees or need to physically return items – easy!

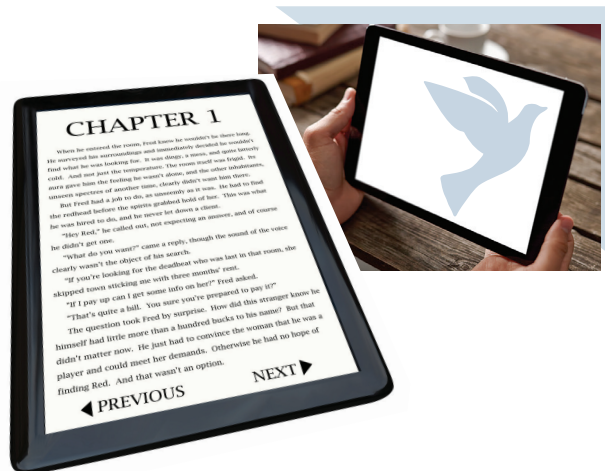

WE BRING THE LIBRARY TO YOU!

Residents of the City of Vincent who are physically unable to visit the library (either temporarily or permanently), plus any live-in carers, may qualify for our free personalised delivery service.

WHAT YOU MAY BORROW

- » Books, including large print
- » Books in languages other than English
- » Books on CD or pre-recorded "PODS"
- » DVDs
- » Jigsaws
- » Magazines
- » Music CDs
- » e-Books and e-Audiobooks
- » e-Magazines

The Library also offers access to the loan of an iPad for members to experience before making the decision to purchase their own.



HOW DO I APPLY?

To apply for membership to the Housebound Readers' Service, simply complete a Housebound Readers' Service Membership Application and return it to us. This is available in hardcopy from the Library or you can download it from our website.

On our website, go to the top 'Library Services' menu and then click the 'Housebound Readers' Service' from the drop down menu.

Once your membership application is received, Library staff will assess it to confirm your eligibility and create a reading profile based on your interests.

Available in other formats and languages.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Housebound Readers' Service will visit every third week. The team will deliver items based on your reading profile. You're encouraged to request specific titles that interest you. You're welcome to use our Inter Library Loans service to borrow items not available at Vincent.

Members will receive a monthly newsletter with current library news, including latest additions to our stock.
