EXPRESSION OF INTEREST



The City acknowledges the importance of young people within our community, and to celebrate and promote the diversity within the 12 to 25 year old age range, we are excited to announce a Youth Art Exhibition held during Youth Week WA 2018. The aim of the 'Who are you?' Youth Art Exhibition is to provide a public exhibition space to showcase young artists, and provide the community with opportunity to access innovative, creative and fresh artwork.

ARTIST BRIEF

'Who are you?' is an opportunity to produce a self-portrait expressing yourself as the unique, creative and exceptional human you are. We want to exhibit the diversity within our community so abstract, expressionist and surrealist art is encouraged.

Your art piece might represent the person you hope to become, a part of yourself you would like to express more, your past, present and future self, or perhaps how your culture, identity or past experience influences your day-to-day life.

ELIGIBILITY

If you are aged between 12 and 25 and live, work, volunteer, study, access services or visit the City of Vincent we invite you to submit your art.

MATERIALS & DIMENSIONS

Art forms eligible for the 'Who are you?' Youth Art Exhibition include:

- Drawing
- Painting
- Printmaking
- Illustration
- Photography
- Sculpture
- Mixed Media

Artwork must be 297mm x 420mm (A3) or smaller with a maximum 30cm depth

INSTALLATION PROCESS

If your artwork is selected for the Art Exhibition, you will need to deliver the piece to YMCA HQ between Monday 9 April and Wednesday 11 April between 9am and 5pm. You will be required to collect your piece between 9am and 5pm at YMCA HQ after the Exhibition finishes.

COPYRIGHT

The City reserves the right to document, reproduce or otherwise use electronic reproduction of the artwork submitted for the 'Who are you?' Youth Art Exhibition for purposes associated with promotion of Youth events, programs and activities within the City of Vincent.

The City will acknowledge the Artist as the author of the Artwork and recognise the Moral Rights of the Artist in accordance with the Copyright Act 1968.

The Artist agrees that the copyright in all artworks created in the course of the contract remain the property of the artist. The Artist shall give the City non-exclusive licence to reproduce the images for related non-commercial purposes including publicity and promotion of the event/project, education and record keeping.

The Artist warrants that the Artworks and any Intellectual Property supplied by the Artist and embodied or used in connection with the Artwork is the sole property of the Artist or the Artist is legally entitled to use the Intellectual Property for the provision of the Artwork.

PARAMETERS

Please adhere to the following guidelines to ensure your artwork is eligible for the Exhibition

- Artwork with explicit, political, sensitive or offensive images or text will not be considered for the Exhibition. This includes racist, sexist, homophobic and transphobic images and text.
- Artwork cannot contain images that promote, glamorise or normalise smoking, alcohol or drug use.
- Artwork must be a self-portrait and not contain images of other people.

HOW TO ENTER

- Complete the application form and attach a digital photo of your artwork before submitting it.
- You must submit your self-portrait and application form by 5pm on Tuesday 3 April 2018 to the Community Partnerships team via email at community.partnerships@vincent.wa.gov.au. If you would like to submit your application in person, please call the Community Partnerships team on 9273 6564.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- After the application cut off, a judging panel will nominate pieces for the Art Exhibition.
- Art pieces will be exhibited at YMCA HQ during Youth Week WA and until the 30 April 2018.
- An exhibition launch will be held at YMCA HQ on Friday 13 April from 6pm-8pm.
- The judging panel will announce a winner and two runner up submissions on Friday 13 April 2018 at the exhibition launch.
- One first place prize of \$1000.
- One runner up prize of \$500.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO EXHIBIT AND ATTEND YMCA HQ.

The Artist will abide by YMCA HQ's Code of Conduct which states:

- No one shall by word or action cause physical or emotional harm to any person within YMCA HQ facility.
- No one shall in any way obstruct the YMCA HQ staff in their control of the centre and its patrons.
- No one will remove YMCA HQ property from the facility without authority.
- No obscene language.
- No hawkers, political parties, religious sects or sales people.
