



## TERMS OF REFERENCE

### 1. AIMS

The Advisory Group will play an important role in encouraging and promoting Arts in the City of Vincent, particularly through the provision of expertise and opinion on the City's public art commissions and percent for art acquisitions.

#### Definitions

A good definition of *the arts* is given by the Free Dictionary as "*imaginative, creative and non-scientific branches of knowledge considered collectively, especially as studied academically.*" *The arts* encompass visual arts, literary arts and the performing arts - music, theatre, dance and film, among others. This list is by no means comprehensive, but only meant to introduce the concept of the arts.

### 2. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Advisory Group are to:

- 2.1 Act in an advisory capacity to advocate and promote arts in the City of Vincent.
- 2.2 Provide advice and make recommendations to the City relating to its art commissions and percent for art acquisitions.
- 2.3 Provide advice on matters generally relating to the arts and associated projects and policies.
- 2.4 Judge the City of Vincent Art Competition/exhibitions and art projects.

### 3. MEMBERSHIP

The Membership of the City of Vincent Arts Advisory Group shall comprise the following persons, with voting rights limited to those persons appointed under clauses 3.1, 3.2 and (on occasion and by invitation) 3.3:

#### 3.1 Two (2) Council Members

Two (2) Council Members.

#### 3.2 Up to Ten (10) Community Representatives

Having experience or qualifications in the arts.

#### 3.3 Representative from West Australian Art Gallery or similar Institute (i.e. University or TAFE)

To be invited as a sessional member of the judging panel for the City of Vincent Art Awards.

#### 3.4 City Officers

The appropriate Director, Manager and Co-ordinator as determined by the Chief Executive Officer.
