



TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. AIMS

The Advisory Group will play an important role in advising on environmental matters in the City of Vincent so that they are compatible with the City's Vision and Strategic Objectives.

2. OBJECTIVES

The Objectives of the Advisory Group are to:

2.1 Act in an advisory capacity on matters relating to the natural and built environment, with specific focus on:

- Water use and efficiency;
- Energy efficiency and renewable energy;
- Environmentally sustainable building design;
- Green spaces, urban vegetation and biodiversity;
- Water in the environment (water quality and natural water sources); and
- Waste minimisation and management.

2.2 Provide advice and make recommendations relating to:

2.2.1 the formulation of a community and Council vision for environmental sustainability; and

2.2.2 the development and implementation of environmental initiatives and programs.

3. MEMBERSHIP

The membership of the City of Vincent Environmental Advisory Group shall comprise the following persons:

3.1 Up to Four (4) Council Members

Up to Four (4) Council Members.

3.2 Up to Ten (10) Community Representatives

Having specialist knowledge and interest in the environmental sustainability of the City of Vincent.

3.3 City Officers

- Director Development Services
- Director Technical Services
- Sustainability Officer (**Responsible Support Officer*)
- Project Officer – Parks and Environment
- Other City Officers (*as required*)
