

## CONDITIONS GOVERNING RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMITS

1. E-Permits are not valid unless activated
2. Permits do not guarantee a parking space in the zone shown thereon.
3. Permits may only be used for parking within the zone stated in the 'Active vehicles' box.
4. Vehicles with active E-Permits outside these designated zones will be subject to the restrictions governing the section of road in which they are parked.
5. Permits do not remove the requirement to comply with the local law for the following areas;
  - 30 minutes or less time limit
  - Loading Zones, No Stopping or No Parking
  - Footpaths, Driveways or Verges
  - Bus or Taxi Stands
  - Clearways
  - Alfresco Dining Areas
  - Ticket Parking Stations / zones
6. Permits are not valid on the main arterial roads (boundary of the zones).
7. Should you vacate your present residence your permits will be deactivated.
8. Permits cannot be issued for, or used for parking of Commercial Vehicles.
9. Where special areas have been set aside for Residential Parking, Permits will only be valid in those areas.
10. The intent of the parking permit is to allow the resident and visitors to their property to park within the nominated parking zone
11. Residential parking permits are to be provided free of charge to tenants. They are not to be sold, leased, hired or provided in exchange for any form of remuneration.
12. The City reserves the right to revoke any permit at any time.
