RE: FIFA Women's World Cup Australia & New Zealand 2023[™] Road Restrictions

On 22 July 2023, the world's largest women's sporting event, the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023[™] will kick off across Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand. Perth Rectangular Stadium will host five matches as part of the Tournament.

Event planning has commenced in conjunction with the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023[™] and the City of Vincent and we have been working through traffic management and road closure measures with a focus on minimising disruption to residents and businesses throughout the period. We can now confirm the below streets will be impacted on match days:

- Pier Street
- Bulwer Street
- Brewer Street
- Wright Street
- Lacey Street
- Smith Street
- Brisbane Street
- Dilhorn Lane

Traffic Management will be in place from three (3) hours prior to each match start time until one and a half (1.5) hours after the match ends. Access to these streets during affected hours will only be available by showing a FIFA Local Access Permit. Permits will be physical, and you are required to present your permit at the checkpoint to allow access. Permits are required to be hung from your rearview mirror when parked for easy identification on match days. There is a limit of 2 (two) access permits per household. Please refer to the highlighted sections in the attached map in conjunction with the above list to understand if you are required to apply for a permit.

For residents of Pier Street, Brewer Street and Bulwer Street (east of roundabout)

There will be **no on-street parking** available during the times listed above. Access will only be permitted to those residents with private drive access. If on-street parking is required, the issued permit can also be used for on-street parking on other streets listed above.

Please be aware that any vehicles in violation of the on-street parking restriction will be towed.

How To Apply

The application process has now commenced, and you can apply for a Local Access Permit for your vehicle to gain access to your residence during the affected periods by completing the online form at vincent.wa.gov.au/wwc. If you are unable to complete the form online, please call the City of Vincent on 08 9273 6000.

- Deadline: All requests must be submitted to the City of Vincent by no later than close of business on **23 June 2023**.
- Collection: You will be notified by email when your Local Access Permit is ready for collection. Permits will be available for collection at the City of Vincent Administration Centre, 244 Vincent Street (cnr Loftus Street), Leederville between 8.30am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday.
