THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED IF APPLYING FOR DEMOLITION APPROVAL FOR A PROPERTY CONTAINING ASBESTOS MATERIAL

This application is designed to correctly identify and safely manage asbestos removal as part of a building demolition process. The necessary work precautions to be adopted in the asbestos removal process vary, depending on the type and quantity of asbestos, its condition, age and location.

It is requested that the applicant complete the form succinctly and thoroughly, in order to assist with the safe management of asbestos products onsite, and to allow for the City's Health Services to better assess the handling of asbestos during the demolition process. It is advised that failure to complete all sections appropriately may result in the Demolition Licence for the property being withheld until compliance is achieved.

ASBESTOS REMOVAL PROCEDURE DETAILS

I _____ confirm that the following procedure will be undertaken for the handling and management of asbestos at the site:

PRIOR TO REMOVAL		
The City's Health Services will be notified on 9273 6533 or at mail@vincent.wa.gov.au at least 24 hours prior to commencing demolition of buildings containing asbestos.		
Neighbouring residents within a 50m vicinity of the site must be notified 24 hours prior to the asbestos removal.		
The property will have signs and barriers erected to warn that 'asbestos removal is in progress', and to prevent unauthorised persons from entering.		
DURING REMOVAL		
All persons onsite must comply with the requirements of the <i>Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996</i> and <i>Occupational Safety and Health Act 1984</i> in relation to asbestos removal.		
All persons onsite must wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) such as full body, single piece, disposal coveralls and either a Class L or M (P2 respirator) disposal mask during the asbestos removal process. Once works are completed, all the PPE must be placed in marked bags with the words 'asbestos waste' for removal with the bulk asbestos waste.		
NO high pressure sprays or hoses will be used on any asbestos products.		
NO power tools will be used on asbestos products, with the exception of removing screws/bolts.		
Asbestos will be wet down with water/PVA solution and will be kept wet during the removal process.		
All asbestos sheets will be removed with minimal breakage and will be cautiously lowered to the ground, not dropped or thrown.		
Asbestos cement residue remaining in the removal area must be cleaned using an approved vacuum.		
The full portion of asbestos fence sheeting will be removed from below and above ground – breaking off of fence sheeting to leave asbestos portions below ground is deemed an offence.		
SUBSEQUENT TO REMOVAL		
All asbestos must be removed from the site prior to demolition of remaining buildings commencing.		
The removed asbestos will be immediately stored on black polythene sheeting, wrapped and sealed into appropriate bundles for disposal.		
All waste containing asbestos will be labelled with the words 'CAUTION ASBESTOS' in 50mm high letters and disposed of at an approved landfill site in accordance with the <i>Health (Asbestos) Regulations 1992</i> .		

Should you answer 'NO' to any of the above, you must contact the City's Health Services on 9273 6533 prior to submission of this form.

Please note: A copy of the relevant Worksafe Asbestos Licence must be attached to this application.

DECLARATION

I have read and understand the requirements for safe handling, removal and disposal of asbestos as set out in the *Occupational Health and Safety Act 1984*, *Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996*, the *Health (Asbestos) Regulations 1992* and the National Code of Practice for the Safe Removal of Asbestos. I understand the requirements placed upon me for the safe removal of asbestos by the relevant legislation and understand that I must take all reasonable measures to ensure asbestos is handled safely. I understand that if I fail to comply with the above requirements, I will be committing an offence under the *Health (Asbestos) Regulations 1992* and may be liable to enforcement action under the *Health Act 1911 (as amended)*.
