PRIOR TO REMOVAL					
The property will have signs and barriers erected to warn that 'asbestos removal is in progress' and to prevent unauthorised persons from entering.					
Notification will be provided to surrounding properties, prior to removal of asbestos.					
DURING REMOVAL					
All persons onsite will comply with the requirements of the Work Health and Safety (General) Regulations 2022 and the Code of Practice - How to Safely Remove Asbestos, in relation to asbestos removal.					
All persons onsite will wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) such as coveralls, gloves, eye protection and P2 disposable respirator. Once asbestos removal is completed, the PPE will be placed in marked bags labelled 'asbestos waste' for disposal with the asbestos waste.					
No high pressure sprays or hoses will be used on any asbestos products.					
No power tools will be used on asbestos products, with the exception of removing screws/bolts.					
Asbestos will be wet down with water/PVA solution and kept wet during the removal process.					
All asbestos sheets will be removed with minimal breakage and will be cautiously lowered to the ground, not dropped or thrown.					
Asbestos cement residue remaining in the removal area will be cleaned using an approved vacuum.					
Asbestos fence sheeting will be removed in full intact pieces from below the ground surface.					
POST REMOVAL					
All asbestos will be removed from the site prior to demolition of remaining buildings commencing.					
The removed asbestos will be immediately stored on black polythene sheeting, wrapped and sealed into appropriate bundles for disposal.					
All asbestos waste will be labelled with the words 'CAUTION ASBESTOS" in 50mm high letters and disposed of at an approved landfill site.
