
ASBESTOS REMOVAL DECLARATION

DEMOLITION COMPANY DETAILS



Health (Asbestos) Regulations 1992 Work Health and Safety (General) Regulations 2022 Code of Practice, How to Safely Remove Asbestos

The purpose of this declaration form to identify and safely manage asbestos removal as part of a building demolition process. The necessary work precautions to be adopted in the asbestos removal process, may vary depending on the type and quantity of asbestos, its condition, age and location.

NOTE: Contractors removing more than 10m² of asbestos will be required to hold a WorkSafe licence.

PROCEDURES				
Check each box, as a true and correct record, acknowledging compliance				
PRIOR TO REMOVAL				
The property will have signs and barriers erected to warn that 'asbestos removal is in progress' and to prevent unauthorised persons from entering.				
Notification will be provided to surrounding properties, prior to removal of asbestos.				
DURING REMOVAL				
All persons onsite will comply with the requirements of the <i>Occupational Safety and Health Act 1984</i> and <i>Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996</i> and in relation to asbestos removal.				
All persons onsite will comply with the requirements of the Work Health and Safety (General) Regulations 2022 and the Code of Practice, for the Safe Removal of Asbestos, 2 nd Edition (NOHSC: 2002 (2005)) and the Code of Practice – How to Safely Remove Asbestos, in relation to asbestos removal.				
All persons onsite will wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) such as coveralls, gloves, eye protection and P2 disposable respirator. Once asbestos removal is completed, the PPE will be placed in marked bags labelled 'asbestos waste' for disposal with the asbestos waste.				
No high pressure sprays or hoses will be used on any asbestos products.				
No power tools will be used on asbestos products, with the exception of removing screws/bolts.				
Asbestos will be wet down with water/PVA solution and kept wet during the removal process.				
All asbestos sheets will be removed with minimal breakage and will be cautiously lowered to the ground, not dropped or thrown.				
Asbestos cement residue remaining in the removal area will be cleaned using an approved vacuum.				
Asbestos fence sheeting will be removed in full intact pieces from below the ground surface.				
POST REMOVAL				
All asbestos will be removed from the site prior to demolition of remaining buildings commencing.				
The removed asbestos will be immediately stored on black polythene sheeting, wrapped and sealed into appropriate bundles for disposal.				
All asbestos waste will be labelled with the words 'CAUTION ASBESTOS" in 50mm high letters and disposed of at an approved landfill site.				
DECLARATION				
 that an asbestos assessment has been conducted of all buildings, structures and fencing to be demolished at the property; confirm that above procedures will be undertaken for the management of asbestos at the property; I understand the requirements for safe handling, removal and disposal of asbestos set out in the Health (Asbestos) Regulations 1992, Work Health and Safety (General) Regulations 2022 and the Code of Practice, for the Safe Removal of Asbestos, 2nd Edition (NOHSC: 2002 (2005)) and the Code of Practice – How to Safely Remove Asbestos, in relation to asbestos removal. I understand that if I fail to comply with the above requirements, I will be committing an offence under the Health (Asbestos) Regulations 1992 and may be liable to enforcement action.
