Underground power works on Oxford Street

Western Power and the City of Vincent are working together to convert the overhead electricity distribution network in your area to underground power.

As part of this project, Western Power will soon be working on Oxford Street between Scarborough Beach Road and Salisbury Street to install underground cabling and LED streetlights to replace existing poles and overhead powerlines.

Works are expected to commence in late May and will be delivered in stages along Oxford Street over the coming months.

The City is working closely with Western Power and their contractor MME to plan these works to minimise impacts on local businesses and residents. This includes staging work zones where possible, maintaining pedestrian access to businesses and managing temporary parking changes.

During construction, there may be short-term changes to parking, some noise at times and localised work zones on the footpath or road.

MME will keep you informed at each stage of the works via letter and the City will work with Western Power to support businesses and keep the community informed as the project progresses.

Businesses are encouraged to share any specific operational requirements (such as deliveries, peak trading times or upcoming events), concerns or practical suggestions that may help reduce impacts during construction.
