## Upcoming Works in Your Area – Preliminary Service Locating

19 May 2026

Dear Residents and Business Owners,

We hope this letter finds you well.

As a courtesy, we would like to provide you with as much notice as possible regarding upcoming works within your area as part of the Overhead to Underground Power Project. These works form part of the broader project to place existing overhead power services underground and remove the existing overhead power lines.

### Upcoming Preliminary Works - This Week

During this week, you may notice service locating personnel working within your area undertaking preliminary scanning activities. These service locating investigations are a critical part of our planning and methodology process. The information gathered allows our team to safely undertake future underground works; avoid impacts to existing underground power and utility services; minimise disruptions to surrounding businesses and residents; and better plan construction activities to reduce impacts to access and surrounding infrastructure.

These works will involve:

- The use of non-invasive underground scanning equipment to identify existing underground services and infrastructure;
- Personnel walking through the area with scanning devices; and
- Minor temporary presence within surrounding streets and parking areas.

*Please note:*

- These works are considered low impact in nature;
- No interruptions to power, property access, businesses, or residents are anticipated during this stage; and
- The activities are simply part of our pre-location and investigation process, so there is no need for concern if you notice crews within the area.

### **Detailed Service Locating Works – Expected from Next Week**

From next week onwards, we are expecting to commence more detailed service locating investigations. These works are slightly more invasive in nature and are essential to ensure our future construction activities can proceed safely without impacting existing underground utilities or services.

These works may involve:

- A utility vehicle and trailer temporarily occupying a small number of parking bays;
- Temporary barriers and traffic management measures around active work areas;
- The temporary removal of small sections of brick paving; and
- Drilling of minor core holes to allow underground services to be identified, marked, and verified for construction planning purposes.

*Please note:*

- Temporary barriers and traffic management devices will be removed once daily activities are complete;
- There are currently no intentions to install permanent locating poles or permanent infrastructure as part of these investigations; and
- Any impacted areas will be reinstated as close as reasonably possible to their original condition following completion of the works. **MME Underground Services** is responsible for any reinstatement work. They won't cover repairs done by third parties, so please coordinate directly with them for any concerns.
