4.1 Smoke Free Town Centres (CD) (refer **Attachment 1 - Smoke Free Town Centre Maps**)

We are seeking community and business feedback on the draft boundaries for five smoke free Town Centres (a priority in our Public Health Plan 2020 – 2025). The Town Centres include – Leederville, Mount Hawthorn, Beaufort Street, North Perth and William Street. Smoking would not be permitted on public land which would include public footpaths and public open spaces such as parks within a smoke free Town Centre boundary.

The reason for this project is to reduce community exposure to harmful environmental tobacco smoke and create healthy environments for people to live, work and play. Eighty-five percent of the

community highlighted that smoke free environments were important for their health and wellbeing as there is no safe level of exposure to environmental tobacco smoke which can be the cause of preventable disease and premature death.

4.2 Vincent Wayfinding Strategy and Accessibility (MR) (refer **Attachment 2 - Vincent Wayfinding**)

A draft project outline is attached. We are seeking feedback on the proposed timing of town team consultation and the level of involvement which is being sought as part of this project, with particular emphasis being placed on the background analysis and the gaining of a thorough understanding of each town centre.
