3. Business

3.1 Public Open Space (POS) Strategy

WG presented the POS Strategy update including some graphs and first impressions from the Consultant's Draft report. In addition, the initial feedback from the public consultation was summarised. He encouraged all to complete the feedback form attached to the Agenda if not done as yet. ACTION: ALL

3.2 40KMH Speed Zone Trial

AM advised the leaflet and survey were ready to go, to commence initial consultation. The City of Vincent (CoV) is still awaiting information from Main Roads regarding possible signage strategy and updated costings. FS advised that CoV can make a grant application to the RSC once costings have been received from MRWA. Discussion ensued about perceived rather than actual speeding on local roads and the difficulty of engaging WA Police in enforcing changes. EC advised that a working group was to be created which included representatives from SES, WA Police, RSC, DoT and others. LD advised of 'Tactical Urbanism' presentation at the AITPM conference (July 24-27) which could highlight possible alternative treatments.

His role as Transport and Safety Manager has involved substantial consultation with Main Roads WA and he also sits on the Road Safety Commission's Vulnerable Road User Advisory Group.

FS presented copies of the Mount Hawthorn and North Perth Primary School Access Guides which have been developed in conjunction with the schools and the DoT (Kylla's is still in production). These will be used to highlight convenient walking and cycling routes to school and are part of the YOUR MOVE toolkit.
