## 3.3 Update on Previous Agenda Items

### 3.2.1 Works Program Progress

Bike Boulevard Phase Two:

- Major profiling and asphalt works complete. Concrete pinch points and tree wells will be completed in mid-July. Tree planting will begin in late July.
- MRWA have line-marking plans for approval.
- Budget has been exceeded but DoT has agreed to meet the overspend figure.

### 3.2.2 Loftus Street Bike lane

Funding has been approved. Challenge has arisen where a representative from a local conservation group has advised that the potential path may interfere with roots of remnant jarrah trees in Keith Frame Reserve.
