The Youth Action Plan 2026 and Beyond is our plan to support young people aged 10 – 25.

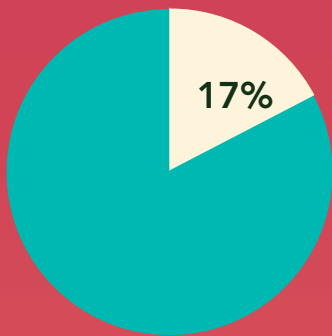

- kind, respectful and supports young people to be their best

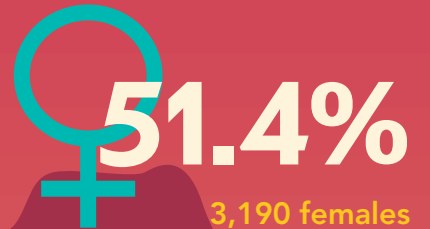


THE NUMBERS

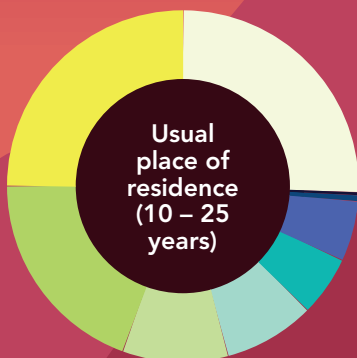


6,207

Having a say in decisions and being listened to.



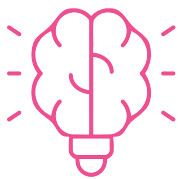
Free places to hang out, study and meet friends.
